
A US dollar bill makes a 4.5cm (2 inch) tall model.




1. Mountain-fold and unfold, crease touching the frames of the 1s.




2. Pleat. The word "States" is framed between the mountain-folds.




3. Turn over.




4. Right edge touches top center.




5. Swivel-squash. The mountain-fold is the crease from step 2. The long raw edge will be parallel to bottom edge.
