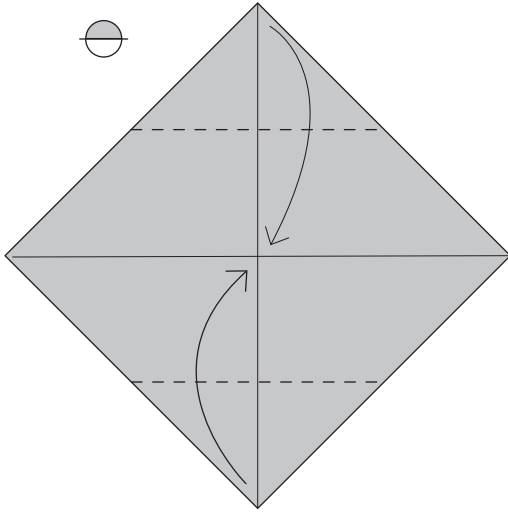
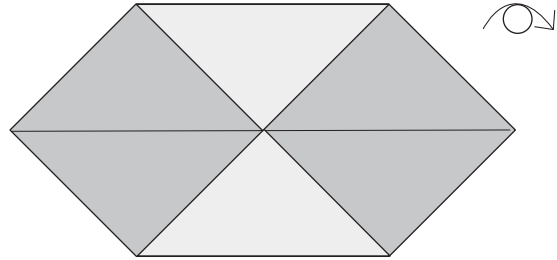


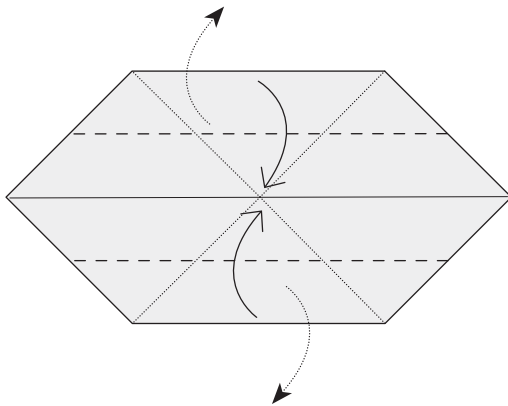
Intermediate
A 15cm (6 inch) square makes a 10cm (4 inch) long candy.



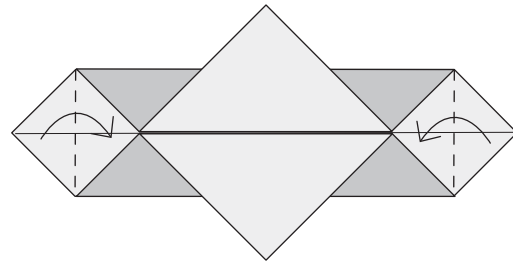
1. Start with a square, colored side up. Fold corners to the center.



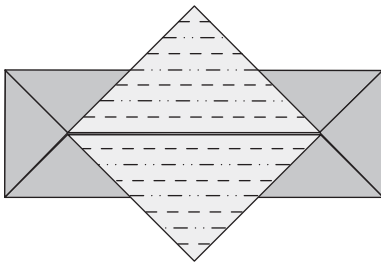
2. Turn over.



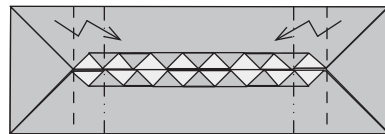
3. Fold edges to center, allowing flaps to swing forward.



4. Valley-fold corners.

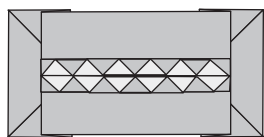


5. Pleat flaps into 8ths.

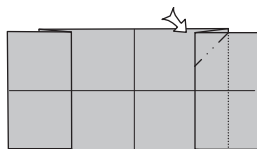


6. Pleat.

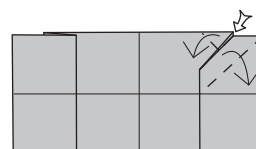

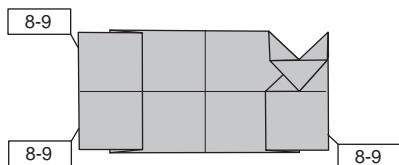
7. Turn over.



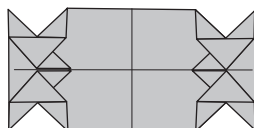
8. Inside-reverse-fold.



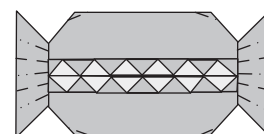
9. A combination of a valley and a squash-fold.



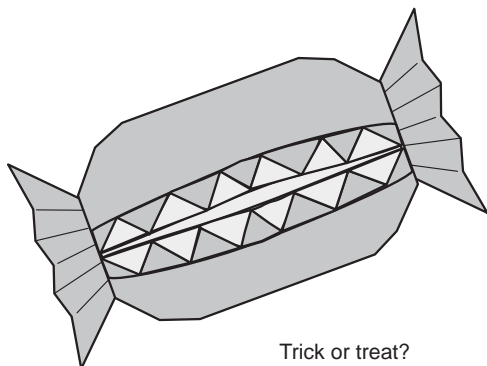
10. Repeat steps 8-9 on other corners.
